### Law. Supreme Court- Criminal Side

The Registra then charged the jury with the prisoners, and read through the indictment which contained twenty counts, as before stated, charging the prisoners with the murder of a black aboriginal child; the counts varying the person of the child, as a male, and a female child to the Attorney –General unknown, and as a black aboriginal named Charley.
