An aboriginal black, a shrewd and intelligent man, who has been servant to several persons in and about the town for some years, and in whom Mr Prentice placed good confidence. On the occasion alluded to, the black(named Dickey) was sent into the boat with an assigned servant, and was entrusted with a letter containing \$5, to be delivered to a person at Newcastle. Dickey, however, conjecturing by the bulk that it contained money, opened the letter, took the money, and walked off to spend it.
