Death of an aboriginal. – An aboriginal native; known by the name of Shingleman, about 28 years of age, on Thursday afternoon went to the house of James Prescott, in Clarence street, for whose family Shingleman had been in the habit of fetching water from the fountain, and complained of being ‘ill all over,’ as he appeared to be very ill, and the night was inclined to be wet, Mr. Prescott allowed him to remain in his kitchen.
