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Transcribed diary of George Muddle.

1823. I was born on the 4th January 1823 in the Parish of Isveil, Sussex England my father went to live at Eastwood in 1825 my mother died there then I went to live with my Grandmother at streel in the Parish of Buxted. In 1826 my father married again then i went home to my fathers again, he was living up in the streel park. In 1827 i commenced going to School at Francesfield Sussex. In 1828 we removed down to a place called Lowland on the same estate as streel and i went to school at Mr Hilders and went to school at Buxted Bridge and to Uckfield. In 1829 went to live up to Hadlerdown and i still went to Uckfield School. 1830 went to live at eastwood and kept going to Uckfield school. In 1833 i went to Crowborrow school again and used to get a new suite Close every Christmas my father was a daily labourer he used to get employment at Mr Winters and at Howbourne 1836 i left school then went to work at Mr Winters and at Howbourne and other places. 1838 my father talked about going to New South Wales accordingly on the 29th April 1838 Monday we started up to Mr Starrs at Crowborrow to meet the barriers Waggon. Tuesday 30th April we arrived at Gravesend and went on board the ship William Metcalf we set sail some time in this night on 5th May we arrived at Plimmouth we stayed there till the 14 May then we set sail for Sydney we arrived at Sydney on the 31st August 1838 we stayed at Sydney till Wednesday 5th Sep then went on board the Steamer the Maitland about 10 Oclock we start for Morpeth we had a head wind we could not land at Newcastle we had to return to Sydney

1838 September Sydney

we got into Sydney about daylight Friday morning the 7th Sep we stayed in Sydney till Saturday night then we started again and got up to Morpeth about 1 O'clock on Sunday 9th Monday 10 we started up to Mr Townsend Paterson River we stayed there a fue days then we went up to Mr Davison Penhurst upper Paterson then went to Mr Hardys then i went to live at Dr Longs for a fue weeks Mr lent me to him as they were badly of for a servant then i went back to Mr Hardy then i went to live at Dr Longs again, he hired me for six Mounths at the rate of £5.0.0 per year my Close and rastion. i went to live there on the 3rd February 1839 then i went to live at Mr C Boydells Camerallyn and stoped there 12 months for my Close and ration he gave me £4 at Christmas and £5 when i left him i went home to my father and stopped at home about six weeks then i went to live at Mr A Glennies Glenthorne i went there on the 18th and lived there for 5 years and 4 Mounths then i went to live at Mr C Boydells again and lived there 12 Mounths at £16 per year then i left and went to stope up at Moores for a fue weeks and done some reeping for Mr Steers at Mr A Glennies and tied up some grape vines for Mr Glennie on the 2nd December 1846 i got married to Elizabeth Moores we was married by the Wright Rvd Lord Bishop Broughton in st Marys Church Upper Allyn river New South Wales on the 29 December 1846 I went to live at Mr. C. Boydells again at £18 per year then i commenced keeping Daily account

1847 January Camerallyn

Friday 1 i went Chipping in the vineyard i got the blight very bad the flies were very troublesome

Sunday 3	i went to Mr Robinsons the shoemaker in the evening
Mond 4	went thrashing Corn
Tues 5	went to thrash and clean Corn and pack flour
When 6	me and Wm Dugle went to the Paterson with maize and flour for Smiths boat
Thurs 7	we came home we brought home Sugar Soap and Candles the Rev Mr Smith sale is today at the Paterson
Frid 8	went for the bullock then went drawing stone for the Mill dam at the watterfalls
Sater 9	went Cleaning Corn
Sund 10	i went hurding Cattle in the flat all day Moore and Mrs Moore came down to our place Betsy was ver ill all day and in the night
Mond 11	went for the bullocks me & Mumford and sam Osburn Clarke and the Overseer went to mend a bridge past Mr Dugle
Tues 12	went to mend the road at the mill at the waterfalls
When 13	we went to mend the road to bring Tom Garland wheat to the Mill
Thurs 14	went Chipping down bushes in the Paddock then went packing flour then went to bring the hoes home
Frid 15	went to Chip the bushes in the Paddock then went to the Shede because it rain then to the Chipping again
Sater 16	we went Scrubing in the Paddock again the river was very high
Sun 17	stoped at home all day
Mond 18	we could not get over the river so we went scrubbing in the paddock again
Tuesd 19	we went round to the Mill to see if we could get over the river on the boat but it was gone so we had to stop and scrub on our side again

1847 January Camerallyn

When 20	went Scrubing again
Thur 21	went scrubing again
Frid 22	went cleaning out the Mill race
Sat 23	went cleaning out the Mill race
Sun 24	went up to Moore in the evening
Mond 25	went wheeling stone at the Mill
Tue 26	went wheeling stone at the Mill
When 27	went wheeling stone at the Mill then then went scrubing down by Mic Brinning
Thur 28	went scrubing in the big Paddock frunt the house
Friday 29	went to scrub till Breakfast John Scott left and we went in his hut in the garden
Sater 30	went wheeling stuf at the Mill then went hay making did nothing after diner it rained

Sun 31 went up for my meat and stoped at home all day

Febuary

Mond 1st went wheeling stuf at the mill Betsey was very in the night

Tues 2 went wheeling stuf at the mill Betsey was a little better

Wen 3 went clearing the things away from the mill as the river was riseing then went scrubing in the padock

Thur 4 went scrubing then went hay making

Fri 5 went scrubing the Paddock Betsey was very ill she was worse in the night went to build hay stack

Sater 6 went scrubing then went carring hay Betsey ill in the night

Sun 7 stoped at home all day

Mon 8 went scrubing then went cutting grapes

Tues 9 went scrubing then went cutting grapes

When 10 went to help to load the drays then went hay making till the rain stoped us then went to work at the mill dam putting in a sleeper and throwing in stones to fill up the holes

1847 Febuary Camerallyn

Thur 11 went drawing sleeper for the dam then went for fire wood

Frid 12 went turning Tobacco in the shede

Sater 13 went to the mill throwing down stuf all day

Sun 14 Betsey and i went up to her fathers and my father

Mon 15 went throwing down stuf for the dam and cutting grapes

Tues 16 went throwing down stuf for the dam then i went to the Paterson with Mr Newcomb to bring back the horse

When 17 went to the dam again and carring hay and cuting grapes

Thurs 18 went to the dam again and cuting grapes

Frid 19 went to help load the drays and went scrubing and cuting grapes my inside was very bade

Sater 20 went scrubing then came home i was very ill i was very ill in the night with the head acke

Sund 21 we stoped at home

Mon 22 Wm Dugle and i went to the Paterson

Tues 23 we came home from the Paterson

When 24 went scrubing and cuting grapes

Thurs 25 went scrubing then went up to McEvoy's for Corn

Friday 26 i went to Hinton and to Morpeth to take a horse down for the Master to take to Sydney to sale and to bring back the Carrage horses the Master and Mrs went to Sydney

Sater 27 i came home with the three carrage horses the flies was very trublesome

Sundy 28 went out in the bush to see our little heifer but we did not find her Betsey and i

March

Mon 1st went for wood and seedar board at the waterfall

Tues 2 went cleaning out the Mill race

When 3 went to the mill dam all day

Thur 4 went mending fence then went to turn the Mangal then went to the Mill to work

1847 March Camerallyn

Frid 5 went to work at the mill

Sat 6 went to turn the layer for Mr Caskle

Sun 7 went over to Harriet

Mond 8 went to turn the layer again

Tues 9 went to turn the layer again

When 10 went to the Paterson

Thur 11 Came home from the Paterson

Friday 12 went Carring hay

Sater 13 went Carring hay

Sun 14 stoped at home

Mon 15 went Carring hay and brought a load wood for the stove

Tue 16 went to Carry Stapeltons wheat to the Mill to be thrashed

When 17 went to thrash Stapelton wheat

Thur 18 went to Draw logs for the Sawyer but we could not get home i left the bullock up at Daurmons

Frid 19 went up to Daurman and yoked the bullock then went to draw the log but we had to leave it they cut it up there on the Creek

Sater 20 went drawing green grass to top the hay stack up

Sun 21 went up to Betseys fathers

Mon 22 went to draw logs for the sawyers to make a pitt

Tues 23 went to thrash Nashs wheat at the Mill

When 24 went to brand pigs to go to Sydney Mumford took them to Morpeth then went drawing straw away from the Mill

Thur 25 went drawing stone for the new Mill at the watter falls

Frid 26 went for lime stones 2 load Wm Dugle and me and for a load wood

Sater 27 went over to Mr Neaves on Parks Creek for corn

Sun 28 stoped at home all day

Mon 29 went to ramsay wheat

1847 March Camerallyn

Tues 30 went to Maitland with three load Tobacco leaf me Wm Dugle and Cinnemone we took the three first load of the contract that Mr Boydell made with McGee

Clark and Waltham he was to deliver 60 tons in 12 months we stoped at the Paterson that night

When 31 we went on to Maitland and delivered the tobacco the Master was there he went on to Plains we stoped at Morpeth that night

April

Thur 1st we came as far as the Paterson that night and stoped there we brought some things from Mr Skinners Morpeth some sugar rope and other things

Frid 2 good Friday we came home

Sater 3 went to draw stone for the new mill at the watter falls

Sund 4 Betsey and i went up to her fathers to diner

Mon 5 went drawing Corn from Peter Camerons ground

Tues 6 went to draw corn again

When 7 went to draw corn again

Thurs 8 Wm Dugle and i went to the Plains with two loads flour and Tobacco we stoped at Glendon Brooke all night in the Paddock Betsey went with us

Frid 9 went on to the Plains and unloaded and came as far as the same place again

Sater 10 we came home

Sun 11 stoped at home all day

Mon 12 went to draw wood

Thurs 13 Wm Dugle and i went to the Paterson with two teams

When 14 we came home

Thurs 15 Wm Dugle and i went up to Stapleton for tobacco 800 lbs then went to draw corn from Barns

1847 April Camerallyn

Frid 16 went for old Peters Corn

Sater 17 went to draw the saved stuf from the island to the Mill at the watter falls then went to draw wood

Sund 18 went up to my fathers and to Betseys fathers

Mon 19 me and Wm Dugle went to draw fencing stuf for the flat at Vantepees

Tues 20 went to draw Wingates things over to Mr Patches from Mr Fenwick

When 21 went to help to Catch the pigs to load the dray to go to the Paterson for Sydney then went to stack tobacco in the shede

Thur 22 went to draw the stuf for old Peters hut over at Nashes by the Mill at the sheep yard and brought a load Hurdle stuf to Vantepees place

Fri 23 went to draw Shingles home out of the big Paddock then went stacking tobacco in the shede

Sater 24 went to help to pack tobacco to go to Maitland

Sun 25 went up to my fathers

Mon 26	went weighing the tobacco and loading it on the drays ready to Maitland Betsey was very in the night
Tues 27	went to the Paterson with 5 loads tobacco we put 4 loads in Smiths boat and one load went to Maitland
When 28	came home
Thur 29	went to empty some meal and to fill the bags with wheat i brought Joseph Hadley the blacksmiths things for £1..10..0 and paid him for them then i went for a load wood and Brought the things home
Fri 30	went for staves for the Cooper and a load wood

Sater 1 st	went up to saw pitt up at Daumans Creek to draw logs for the sawyers and loaded the dray the ring broke i had to leave the dray

When 15 went digging at the garden (16) went driving grape stakes
 Frid 17 went to drive stakes again Betsey she stoped at Mrs Hawkins as i went to a party at Sam Orsbourne the fiddler Wm Dugle was there Sam kept the spree up all the week because his Brother came to see him they had not seen each other for years before
 Sater 18 i stoped at home all day because my head was bade
 Sun 19 stoped home all day
 Mon 20 went up to the saw pitt for sawed stuff and timber carring
 Tues 21 went digging in the garden till Breakfast then went driveing stakes and finished there then went to dig in garden
 When 22 went digging in the garden
 Thur 23 went to digg in the garden till dinner time then went carying water to water the orange tree in the frount of the house
 Frid 24 went digging in the garden till breakfast then went to water the orange trees

Sater 25 watering the orange trees again
 Sund 26 stoped at home all day
 Mon 27 went digging in the garden again
 Tues 28 went digging in the garden again
 When 29 went digging in the garden then went grees the dray and get things ready to go to Maitland tomorrow
 Thur 30 Wm Dugle and i started to Maitland with two teams with 3 tuns flour for sale and one team for sale the Master Mr Boydell sent a lot of horses for sale Mr A Glennie sent his four bullock for sale but he did not sell them Charles Ourness took them down he took the new dray that Mr Caskel made for Mr Hutson Morton bay

October

Frid 1st went into Maitland to the sale the Master sold one team dray and all 3 tuns flour one or two horses

1847 October Camerallyn

Sat 2nd went down to the steamers wharf and took the new dray to go to Morton bay then we came home Brought from Messrs Andrews 8 bags salt for the master and one bag salt for Mr Patch and two small box
 Sund 3 stoped home all day
 Mon 4 went digging in the garden
 Tues 5 went to work in the garden
 When 6 Kenedy and i went poleing hops
 Thurs 7 went up to the Brush for some Curry jung
 Frid 8 went digging in the garden
 Sater 9 went packing leaf tobacco to go to Maitland
 Sun 10 went to Church
 Mon 11 went to help to load the tobacco Wm Dugel and Edwards went to Maitland with the tobacco i went to work in the garden
 Tues 12 went to Chip in the Vineyard
 When 13 went tieing up grape vines and stripping Curry chung
 Thurs 14 went striping Curry chung
 Frid 15 we commenced digging a Cellar and the big shede
 Saterd 16 went to work at the Cellar again
 Sun 17 stoped at home all day
 Mon 18 went to digg the Cellar
 Tues 19 went to dig the Cellar (20) went to the Cellar again
 Thurs 21 Do Do Do (22) do Do Do Do Wm Dugel left
 Sater 23 Do Do Do (24) we stoped at home
 Mon 25 went digging in the garden then went to Harrow the Leggoon flat

Tue 26 went digging in the garden then went to Harrow
 When 27 went to the Paterson with some Baccon and hams and hides for Sydney one bag
 flour for Smith the Boatman
 Thur 28 i came home and brought some things for the Master and some for Mr W
 Boydell. Harriot went to the Paterson with me i bought a fiddle of Wm Dugle for
 £1..0..0 and paid him for it

1847 October Camerallyn

Frid 29 went to draw furrows for Corn in the Brickfield
 Sater 30 went to draw furrows again
 Sun 31 Betsey her mother and i went over to Mr Parks

November

Mon 1st went to draw furrows in the Leggoon for corn
 Tues 2nd went to draw fenseing to the Brickfield and the leggoon
 When 3 went to help to pack tobacco leaf to go to Maitland
 Thurs 4 Nash and i started to Maitland went as far as the Paterson
 Frida 5 went on to Maitland with the tobacco and unloaded all the men where sick at the
 factry then we went on to Morpeth we came back to Dicksons paddock
 Sater 6 we came home (7) stoped at home
 Mon 8 went to plough in Conley flat
 Tuesday 9 went to plough (10) went to plough
 Thur 11 went to wash sheep at waterfalls
 Frid 12 i was ill all day with a great Cold
 Sater 13 went to plough Betsey and i went up to her father in the evening
 Sun 14 we came home
 Mon 15 went Sheep washing
 Tues 16 went to plough i got my boots from William Evret
 When 17 went to plough i went to Dr Parks
 Thur 18 i was ill all day (19) went to plough
 Sater 20 went to plough (21) stoped at home
 Mon 22 went to plough
 Tues 23 went to plough Sam Orsbourne and i went to the Paterson in the night with pigs
 and wool for Sydney
 When 24 we came home (25) went to Millgates on the Creek to reap
 Frid 26 went to draw Carery Wheat over from Parks Creek
 Sater 27 went to draw Cinnamones Wheat
 Sund 28 stoped at home
 Mon 29 Betsey was Confined of a son (**SON Henry**) about $\frac{1}{4}$ past one am O'clock in the
 morning Dr Lindermmon attended on her and Mrs Camerron. i went over for her in

the night i went up for Betseys Mother at Mr Glennies then i went to help to load the dray for to go to Maitland with tobacco leaf

Tues 14 went loading and weighing tobacco to go to Maitland

When 15 Williams Edwards. Nash, and i started to Maitland with leaf tobacco we went as far as the Paterson

Thu 16 we went as far as Dicksons Paddack

Frid 17 we went on to Maitland and unloaded and i went on to Morpeth with a box apples 41 dozn and Brought some things from Mr Skinner and came on to the Paterson

Sater 18 we came home

Sun 19 Betsey and I went up st Marys Church Allyn River to get the baby Cristioned Henry then we went up to my father

Mon 20 went to Harrow over the river by the Mill

Tues 21 went to plough over the river by the Mill and put in corn

When 22 went to Harrow over the river by the Mill

Thur 23 Momford and I went to Millgates and fetched 100 bushels corn on Park Creek

Saterday 1st went cutting lucurn seed till diner

Tues 4	went to feed the bullocks then went to work at the Mill then went feed the bullock again
When 5	went went to feed the Bullocks
Thurs 6	went to feed the bullocks then went thrashing Corn then went weeding the orange trees and feed the Bullocks
Frid 7	went to feed the Bullocks then went chiping in the garden then help to carry Corn up in the loft over the shede then went to feed the bullock
Sater 8	went to harrow barley then went to feed the bullock
Sun 9	went to feed the bullocks
Mon 10	we loaded the drays and started to Morpeth Patcey Conley and i we went as far as the Paterson
Tues 11	went to Morpeth with flour for Captain Fobbs and 4 Cases apples 12 hides 9 skins and two liabery box for Sydney and 28 dozn apple for Mic Brinann we stoped there all night
Wens 12	we came as far as the Paterson John Daumon and Mary Camerron was Maried at Maitland
Thu 13	we came home
