

PROJECT – Book Design and the Arts and Crafts Movement Exhibit

Description: The University of Newcastle has formed an object-based learning collection based on the book designs of William Morris and his Kelmscott Press. The goal of this exhibit is to 1) highlight the use of this collection for teaching and learning and 2) inform the audience of the importance/influence of this movement on book design.

We are seeking a student with a arts/design background to help the Special Collections Librarian in building content for this exhibition.

The goal of the project is the creation of a dual online/in-person exhibition, to be launched in October 2022.

The project tasks would include:

- Learning handling techniques for rare books.
- Selecting and scanning images from rare books.
- Image manipulation using programs such as Photoshop.
- Assisting in the design of exhibition panels.
- Assisting in writing content for exhibition panels.
- Participating as an assistant in Object-Based Learning class visits/sessions, if necessary.
